Course Summary:

A class best suited to those with some previous experience of using clay, this will be a chance to explore form and experiment and 'play' with different making and decorating techniques in a stimulating and supportive atmosphere. We will experiment with hand-building and there will be an opportunity to try working with a wheel. We will experiment with using different approaches to glazing and printing onto clay. Please bring a sketchbook or notebook to jot down your discoveries. There is also a voice recorder which can be used in this way too. You will have the opportunity to exhibit your pieces at the annual Artspace AGM.

Eligibility:

Learners must be aged 19 at the start of the course.

How will the course be taught?

By demonstration, by practical work, with advice and feedback from the tutor, and by working on individual, or occasionally group, projects. The internet may be used as a resource also. Learning logs will be used.

How will I know how well I am doing?

Progress will be considered in relation to your own 'starting point' and personal goals. You will be encouraged to document your own work and results of any experimental tests. Progress will be reviewed through the course, with opportunities for individual and group appraisal throughout.

Prior Knowledge:

This course is suitable for both the experienced and inexperienced. No previous experience is necessary, although previous experience will determine your individual starting point.

What do I need to bring?

You will receive your own 'individual learning log' in the first week of the course, you will need to bring this along to the class each week. You will also need to bring with you a weekly materials contribution of £2 to cover the cost of basic materials. You are also encouraged to bring with you a sketchbook and, if possible a portfolio for storing your work. Portfolios are available to buy from Artspace at a cost of £3.50 if you wish to do so.
