Course Summary:

This qualification can equip you with the IT and computer skills needed for employment. It is designed for those with little experience of using computer applications and will prepare you for the IT challenges of the workplace. Most office jobs require you to have basic keyboard and data entry skills, as well as a basic understanding of how to use software such as Microsoft Office. Even non-office jobs can require some computer training, for example, retail cashier positions require employees to operate complex point-of-sale kiosks and factory positions may require employees to use computers to log their hours worked or to enter production information each day. The units covered in this qualification are:- Spreadsheet Software [using Excel], The Internet and the Web and Using Email (including how to attach a document, read and respond to email and storing email messages appropriately for future use).

Eligibility:

Learners must be over 19 on the 1st September of the academic year they start their learning. Resident in UK for 3 years (some exceptions).
