If your first language is not English, this may be the course for you. This course is for people with very little or no knowledge of English as a second language. You will practice how to tell the time, make and change appointments, give and follow directions, and have basic conversations with friends/neighbours and others in English. You will also practice how to: give, listen to, and pass on messages, verbally and in writing; describe people and objects; and complete various application forms.

Eligibility:

You must be aged 19 at the start of the course. You will need to be eligible for this course, a tutor will check your eligibility, please bring ID if you have been in the UK for less than 3 years.

How will the course be taught?

This course is delivered by a professionally qualified tutor. There will be a mixture of group, paired and individual work. You will also receive homework tasks each week.

How will I know how well I am doing?

You will receive written feedback in your learning log each week along with having your work marked and verbal feedback during the sessions.

Prior Knowledge:

This class is for people who speak no English at all/only a few words. You will do an assessment at the start of the course to find out what level you are currently working towards.
