Course Summary:

This course is designed for people with assessed skill levels from Entry to Level 2, who wish to improve their literacy skills. Topics covered include spelling, grammar, punctuation, reading for meaning, planning and drafting writing, reading for meaning and speaking and listening. You have the chance to achieve a qualification up to level 2 (equivalent to GCSE grade A-C or 9-4). The course is delivered in a way that makes English relevant to everyday life and helps learners to progress in a chosen career or future employment or in order to access other educational opportunities.

Eligibility:

Learners must be aged 19 at the start of the course.

How will the course be taught?

Professionally delivered by a qualified tutor via distance learning and online platform including a reading and writing exam at the end. Speaking and listening will be assessed by the tutor during the teaching sessions.
