Course Summary:

This course is for people whose first language is not English. You will develop your reading skills and understand short texts such as public signs/ notices, maps, forms, letters, emails, adverts, simple appointment and greeting cards. You will be able to read texts for information and undertake essential tasks in your everyday life. There will be an opportunity to take the ESOL Entry 1 reading exam and gain a qualification.

Eligibility:

You must be aged 19 at the start of the course. You will need to be eligible for this course, a tutor will check your eligibility, please bring ID if you have been in the UK for less than 3 years.

How will the course be taught?

This course is delivered by a professionally qualified tutor. There will be a mixture of group, paired and individual work. You will also receive homework tasks each week.

How will I know how well I am doing?

You will receive written feedback in your learning log each week along with having your work marked and verbal feedback during the sessions.

Prior Knowledge:

This class is for people who speak very basic English only. You will do an assessment at the start of the course to find out what level you are currently working towards.
