### Course Summary:

Closed Course. This is a progression course for Recovery College Graduates who would like to train as experts by experience. The Level 3 Award in Education and Training will equip you to peerlead with confidence. You will investigate the roles and responsibilities of a teacher, use inclusive teaching and learning approaches in the classroom and gain an understanding of the types and methods of assessment. This is an introductory, knowledge-based teaching qualification leading to a suite of teacher-training opportunities. You do not need to be teaching to enrol on this qualification.

### Eligibility:

This is a closed course for Recovery College graduates. ### How will the course be taught?

There will be 9 x 3 hour classroom sessions in which you can build your knowledge and practice your skills. We will assess your learning via a variety of methods such as written assignments, professional discussion, reflective journaling and observation. You will also be required to do a 15 minute micro-teach. You will build your portfolio of evidence using Qualls Direct, an online platform.

### How will I know how well I am doing?

Your tutor will give you regular feedback on your progress and you will also be able to monitor your achievements online.

### Prior Knowledge:

This is an introductory, knowledge-based teaching qualification leading to a suite of teacher-training opportunities. You do not need to be teaching to enrol on this qualification.

### What do I need to bring?

Pens, paper, a folder in which to organise your work.
