Course Summary:

This is an introductory teaching course, for people interested in becoming a teacher or trainer in the post-16 education and skills sector. It is also suitable for people who are new to teaching, or who have to deliver teaching or training as part of their role. You may wish to earn money by teaching your hobby, skill or trade to others. This course will provide you with the practice and the confidence to do so.

Course Content

The course will cover the basic skills and knowledge required when teaching:

- * Roles, responsibilities and relationships in education
- * Creating an inclusive learning environment
- * Using inclusive teaching and learning approaches
- * Lesson planning
- * Assessing learning

You are required to complete 3 units with a total of 12 credits. These are as follows:

- * Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education & training (3 credits)
- * Understanding and using inclusive approaches in education & training (6 credits)
- * Understanding assessment in education & training (3 credits)

Start date and course duration are flexible and can be tailored to your situation.

Eligibility:

Learners must be over 19 at the start of the course. There are no formal entry requirements for the course. You need competent English communication skills to complete written assignments and deliver your micro-teach. You will need sufficient digital skills to manage your online portfolio. Within the profession, you need maths and English skills at Level 2 (GCSE grade 4), and we will advise you on further study, if this is identified as an area for development.

How will the course be taught?

You and your tutor will use an online learning platform to keep a record of evidence of your progress and achievements.

You will:

- * Attend 6 group learning sessions
- * Complete written assignments
- * Evaluate basic classroom teaching sessions delivered by your peers
- * Deliver a short micro-teach on a topic of your choice

Assessment of your progress is holistic. We will use a range of methods to ensure that you have covered all aspects of the requirements.

How will I know how well I am doing?

Your tutor will give you regular feedback on your work and you will be able to monitor your progress online.

Prior Knowledge:

There is no prior knowledge or experience required for this introductory course.

What do I need to bring?	You will be provided with course materials. A laptop or computer are the most suitable devices, but a tablet or phone can also be used. You will need internet access.
