This class is for people who come from outside the UK, who speak, read and write some English. You should have at least Entry 3 ESOL. You will practise reading and writing and speaking English. You will learn how to write grammatically correct English to enable you to access the functional skills curriculum.

Eligibility:

Learners must be over 19 on the 31st August of the academic year they start their learning. If not ordinarily resident in UK for 3 years please speak to a member of staff to confirm eligibility for funding.

How will the course be taught?

This course is delivered by a professionally qualified tutor. There will be a mixture of group, paired and individual work. You will also receive homework tasks each week.

How will I know how well I am doing?

You will follow your own individual learning plan with progress recorded by tutors and yourself.

Prior Knowledge:

You will need Entry 3 ESOL English to access this course
