Course Summary:

This course will build your confidence to interact freely with people in English. The course will give you the opportunity to improve your written English- with regular written work being set as homework. It will also focus on developing your English speaking and listening skills.

Eligibility:

The course is free if you are over 19 years old, have lived in the UK for 3 or more years, and have a valid Residence Permit, and are one of the following: Unemployed or earning below £20,319 per year; Qualified below a Level 2 (less than 5 GCSEs); Have mental health challenges, Have a learning difficulty or disability. It is also free for some other learners, contact fay.tucker@gloucestershire.gov.uk to check eligibility.

How will the course be taught?

Learning will take place in small friendly groups on Zoom. We will use a range of individual and group work, demonstration and discussion.

How will I know how well I am doing?

You will follow your own individual learning plan with progress recorded by tutors and yourself.

You will need a phone, tablet or computer with access to the internet so that you can join the course on Zoom. It is also a good idea to bring a notepad and pen.
