Eligibility:		Learners must be over 19 on the 31st August of the academic year they start their learning. If not ordinarily resident in UK for 3 years please speak to a member of staff to confirm eligibility for funding.		
How will the course be taught?		This course is delivered by a professionally qualified tutor. There will be a mixture of group, paired and individual work. You will also receive homework tasks each week.		
How will I know how well I am doing?		You will receive written feedback in your learning log each week along with having your work marked and verbal feedback during the sessions.		
Prior Knowledge:		This class is for people who write no English at all/only a few words/letters who need to learn to write in English, but whom do have an understanding of some spoken English. You will complete an assessment at the start of the course to find out what level you are currently working towards.
